On Oct. 21st, MHS will be offering the SAT for seniors and PSAT for sophomores and juniors. These assessments are free for students who sign up. However, if you fail to attend without a valid reason, you will be charged for the unused assessment. There is a short deadline to sign-up as two Parent Square messages were sent out during the summer. **Please sign up by Monday, 9/14 by 3:30pm.**

Why is taking the SAT/PSAT beneficial?

- College Readiness & Admissions:** The SAT is widely accepted by colleges for admissions, and the PSAT helps students practice for the SAT.
 - Scholarship Opportunities:** High scores on the PSAT can qualify students for the National Merit Scholarship and other awards.
 - Skill Benchmarking:** Both tests measure critical reading, writing, and math skills needed for college and career success.
 - Personalized Practice:** PSAT results connect to free SAT prep resources, helping students improve before the real exam.
 - College & Career Planning:** Scores provide feedback on academic strengths and areas for growth, aiding in course selection and future planning.
- Waterfall Clinic Use: For any student that needs to be seen at the Waterfall Clinic on campus you must FIRST go to Student Services to get a pass. Otherwise, you will be marked absent.

Student Reminder: We do not accept Door Dash or other food delivery services at the offices. We have informed the businesses that we will not allow them on campus. Students need to make other arrangements for off campus pick up.
